

Jenny T.'s Weekend Project

A Halloween Quilt



Finished Size: 49 1/2" x 58"

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Supplies You'll Need

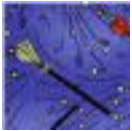
1 panel of Halloween fabric (1 yard)



Yellow Fabric

Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" x 37"

Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" x 41 1/2"



Blue Broom Fabric

Cut 2 strips 6" x 37"

Cut 2 strips 6" x 41 1/2"



Green Fabric

Cut 2 strips 1 1/2" x 50"

Cut 2 strips 1 1/2" x 56 1/2"

Cut and piece a bias strip that is 2" x 220" OR buy 1/2" double folded binding.

Fabric for back of quilt (3 yards)

Low loft batting or preferred batting (51" x 60")

Thread

Quilting Thread

Rotary Cutter

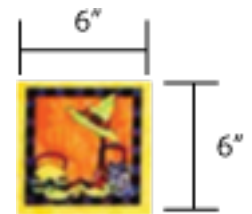
Cut Your Fabric

Cut out the main image from the fabric panel plus some of the surrounding fabric. This should measure 33" x 41 1/2"



Cut out 4 of the graphic squares plus some of the surrounding fabric. These should each measure 6" x 6"

There are several squares to choose from... choose the 4 you like!



Piece Your Quilt

1. Lay a 2 1/2" x 41 1/2" yellow strip along the left edge of the panel... right sides together.
2. Sew a 1/4" seam. Repeat for the right side of the panel.
3. Press the seams away from the panel.
4. Lay a yellow strip along the top edge of the panel... right sides together.
5. Sew a 1/4" seam. Repeat for the bottom edge of the panel.
6. Press the seams away from the panel.



7. Lay a 6" x 41 1/2" blue strip along the left edge of the panel... right sides together.

8. Sew a 1/4" seam. Repeat for the right side of the panel.

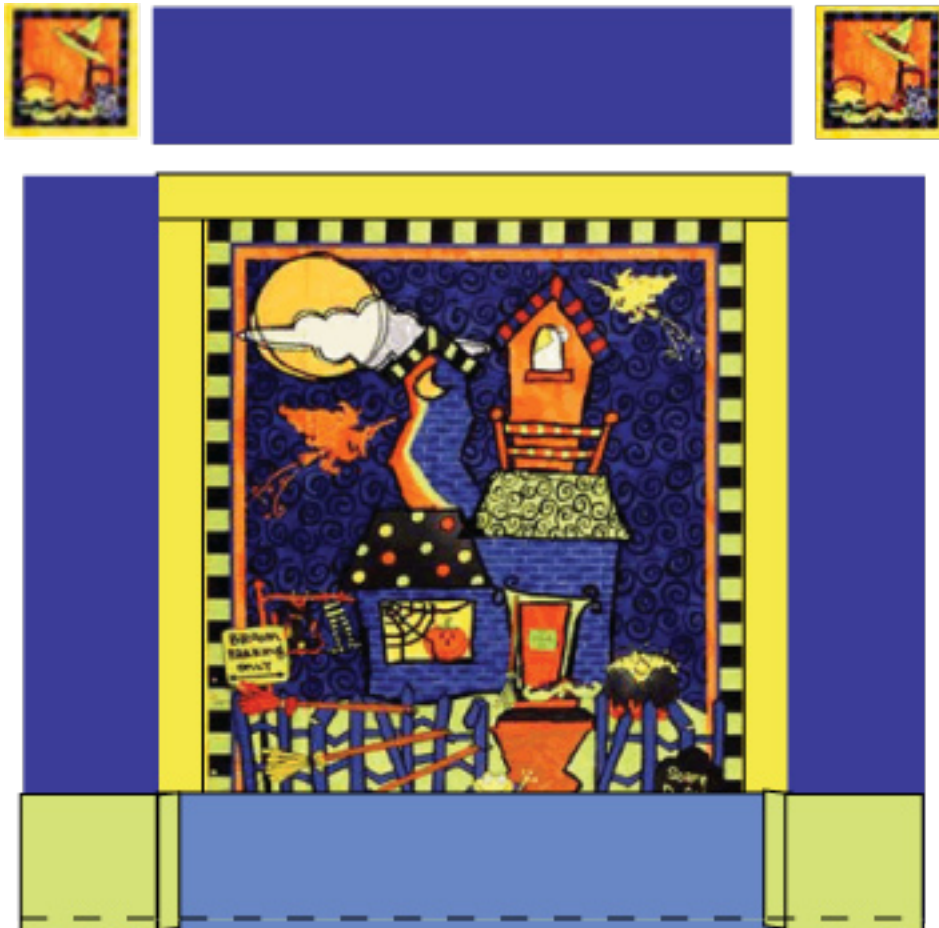
9. Lay a blue strip right side up. Lay a square right side down aligning the left edges.

10. Sew a 1/4" seam. Press the seam toward the blue fabric.

11. Repeat for the right side of the strip.

12. Repeat steps for the remaining blue strip and 2 squares.

13. Lay a pieced blue strip along the top edge of the panel... right sides together. Align the seams... they should easily fit together.



14. Sew a 1/4" seam. Repeat for the bottom edge of the panel.
15. Lay a 1 1/2" x 56" 1/2" green strip along the left edge of the panel... right sides together.
16. Sew a 1/4" seam. Repeat for the right side of the panel.
17. Press the seams away from the panel.
18. Lay a green strip along the top edge of the panel... right sides together.
19. Sew a 1/4" seam. Repeat for the bottom edge of the panel.
20. Press the seams away from the panel.

Quilt Your Quilt

Layer the background fabric, batting and pieced quilt top.

Stitch around the shapes in the panel... following the lines.

Stipple stitch in the sky.

Use fun thread colors and have fun!

Stitch in the ditch along all seams.

Quilt as little or as much as you want.

End the quilting with stitching along the inside of the checkered border.

Bind Your Quilt

Fold the long ends of the bias strip into the center of the strip and press well.

Fold in half again to create double folded binding.

Bind the edges of your quilt.
